



Pacific School Expectations 2017-2018



We expect all students to follow Pacific's school rules:

Character Counts

- Trustworthiness
- Respect
- Responsibility
- Fairness
- Caring
- Citizenship

In order to establish an effective behavior program, it is essential that students understand what behavior is expected of them. The most effective discipline occurs when the home and the school work **together**.

Playground Expectations:

General Rules

1. Students are to be on the playground (not classroom) during all recesses.
2. Respectful language is expected **at all times**. Use of inappropriate language, threats, "Put-Downs", or bullying are never allowed.
3. Students are not to leave the play area during recess **without adult permission**.
4. Basketball hoops and volleyball nets are for **playing**. Please do not **hang** on them.
5. Replace balls on P.E. ball rack at end of recess.
6. Do not bring balls or toys from home to use on the playground.
7. Do not climb trees or play in the bushes on the playground.
8. Children should keep hands and body parts to themselves. No tackling games allowed.
9. Freeze and drop down when bell rings - wait for whistle.

Swings & Slides

1. Hands must be kept **on swings** at all times. Remain **seated** at all times. No jumping off moving swings.
2. Each turn lasts **30 revolutions** (one back and forth cycle) for grades K-2 and **60 revolutions** for grades 3-5.
3. Always slide **feet first** with backside against the slide.
4. **One** person on a slide at a time. Begin sliding **after** the person in front of you **finishes**.
5. Go **down** slide only. No **climbing up** slides.

Jungle Gym / Monkey Bars

1. Use **hands only** to cross the bars. **No hanging** by the knees.
2. Climbing or sitting **on the top of the jungle gym** and "chicken fights" are prohibited.

Rewards: AOK (Act of Kindness) Cards are awarded to students **before and after school**, during lunch, recess, and assemblies for appropriate and exemplary behavior. **Students place the "school copy" in the box located in the cafeteria and take home the "home copy"**.

Consequences: Students who fail to follow yard and cafeteria rules will receive a Grounds Citation. Grounds Citations are cumulative for the entire year.

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|----------------------------------|--|
| 1 st Grounds Citation | Warning. This simply means that a student made a mistake. |
| 2 nd Grounds Citation | 2 days lunch detention, parent contact |
| 3 rd Grounds Citation | 5 days lunch detention, office conference, parent contact |

Lunch detention means that the student eats his/her lunch in the office and remains there during the entire lunch period.
